The ECSRA is very active, on behalf of all the residents of Earl's Court Square. The Executive Committee monitors all RBKC Planning and Licencing Applications affecting Earl's Court Square.

They consult with Members and express the views of residents on traffic and parking within Earl's Court Square and liaise with the local police on crime prevention.

The Executive Committee also liaises with other local organisations and ensures that the Members of the ECSRA have a voice. One of our success stories has been the reduction of rubbish in our area and we have been actively liaising with RBKC who initiated "The Earl's Court Project" to tackle this problem.

The ECSRA produces a Newsletter once a year, which keeps residents up to date on local issues. We hold two events annually in Earl's Court Square Gardens: a Summer BBQ/Disco and a mulled wine and mince pies event at the Lighting of the Christmas Tree, scheduled for December each year.
