2. Managing, stewarding and supporting events and activities in the Meeting Place at North Lodge.
3. Welcoming visitors to Brompton Cemetery.
4. Responding to enquiries and information requests.
5. Promoting Brompton Cemetery, its activities and interpretive materials.
6. Selling literature and other items.

Experience / qualifications / attributes

1. A keen interest in engaging with members of the public, have good communication skills and the ability to be a good Ambassador for the Cemetery and Friends.
2. A keen interest in Brompton Garden Cemetery and a willingness to learn about its history and what it has to offer.
3. Volunteers will be self-sufficient, able to work on their own, using initiative and tact to ensure all requirements are met for both people and facilities.
4. Aware of health, safety and diversity issues, to protect themselves and members of the public.
5. Able to fill out daily work records of tasks carried out.
6. Able to be contacted by mobile telephone and/or landline, with email also very desirable.
7. Available at least four hours each month.
